Sub: TGPSC – Departmental Tests, May-2026 Session for the State Audit Department Test (Paper-IV), (Objective type) (PC.No.123) held on 29-05-2026 AN - Debarred for 2 Years (Four Sessions) - Orders – Issued - Reg.

Ref: 1. Commission's Departmental tests Notification No.02/2026, Dt. 26-02-2026.
2. Special Report received from the Invigilator, Chief Superintendent and Flying Squad of MS ACE Infotech Services, Mahabubnagar.

The Invigilator, Chief Superintendent and Flying Squad of the venue MS ACE Infotech Services, Mahabubnagar in Special Report brought to the notice of the Commission that during the conduct of Departmental Test for P.C. No. 123 - the State Audit Department Test (Paper-IV), (Objective type) one candidate Sri Anand D, bearing Hall Ticket No. 2611801230 had carried a mobile phone into the examination hall and used it to obtain answers during the examination.

In view of the above, during the Examination using a mobile phone inside the examination hall, which is strictly prohibited. This is considered malpractice and the use of unfair means, leading to action under the applicable rules.

As per Common Instructions of Departmental test, Notification No. 02/2026:

- 1. Para VIII(v):-** Candidates will be subjected to frisking to ensure that they are not carrying any electronic or any other gadgets, **mobile/cellular phone**, tablets, pen drives, Bluetooth devices, watch, Programmable calculators, log tables, wallet, purse, notes, Pagers, charts, loose sheets or recording instruments strapped on their body or in their pockets. Possession of the same leads to invalidation of the candidature to the exam.
- 2. Para XI(a) :-** Candidate is liable to be debarred from appearing for any examination permanently or for such term of years as the Commission may think fit for the reason: **(ii) :-** If he/she is found guilty of malpractice of any kind in the Examination Hall.
- 3. Para XI(d):-** Penal provisions of **the Public Examinations (Prevention of Mal practice & Unfair Means) Act 1997 (Act No.25/97) published in A.P. Gazette No. 35 Part-IV-B Extraordinary, dated: 21.08.1997** shall be invoked if malpractice & Unfair means are noticed at any stage of examination and the candidate will be debarred from writing any TGPSC examination in future.
